



#### Know

 The righteous live by faith, and to live by faith is to believe in the Lord and His Word, even though you cannot see Him.





### Understand

- Living by faith means to believe in the Lord and His Word a.k.a. the Holy Bible.
- This means that in response to this belief, you actively choose to keep God's commandments, which is to live by faith or walk by faith. This is what shows genuine faith in the Lord and His Word.





## Do

- You should choose to do God's commandments, which is to live or walk by faith.
- The key to doing God's commandments is written in James 4:17: "To him therefore who knows to do good, and doesn't do it, to him it is sin".
- A simple example of putting the Scripture James 4:17 into practice is THIS: if someone tells or asks you to steal something, you should say no and not do it, because you know that stealing is wrong. Hence, by not doing a wrong, a good is done instead.





## Do


 The concept of living or walking by faith is demonstrated by a clip from the movie, 'Rogue One: A Star Wars Story', where a blind man named Chirrut, believed in the force, which guided his way of life, or rather how he chose to live his life. In the same way, Christians are to believe in the Lord who they cannot see, and whose commandments guide their way of life.

# Main Point

- To walk by faith is to do God's commandments, which can also be referred to as your works. Hence, the Scripture, <u>James 2:18</u>: "8 Yes, a man will say, "You have faith, and I have works." Show me your faith without works, and I will show you my faith by my works." Therefore, without true faith there are no works, but with true faith there are works i.e. doing God's commandments, which is to live a Christian lifestyle.
- Hence, Christians are expected to walk by faith and not by sight, just like Chirrut did, as it is written in the Scripture, 2 Corinthians 5:7, "
  <sup>7</sup> for we walk by faith, not by sight.", and this means that you choose to do God's commandments even though you cannot see Him, but you do them because you have faith in Him and His Word.
